

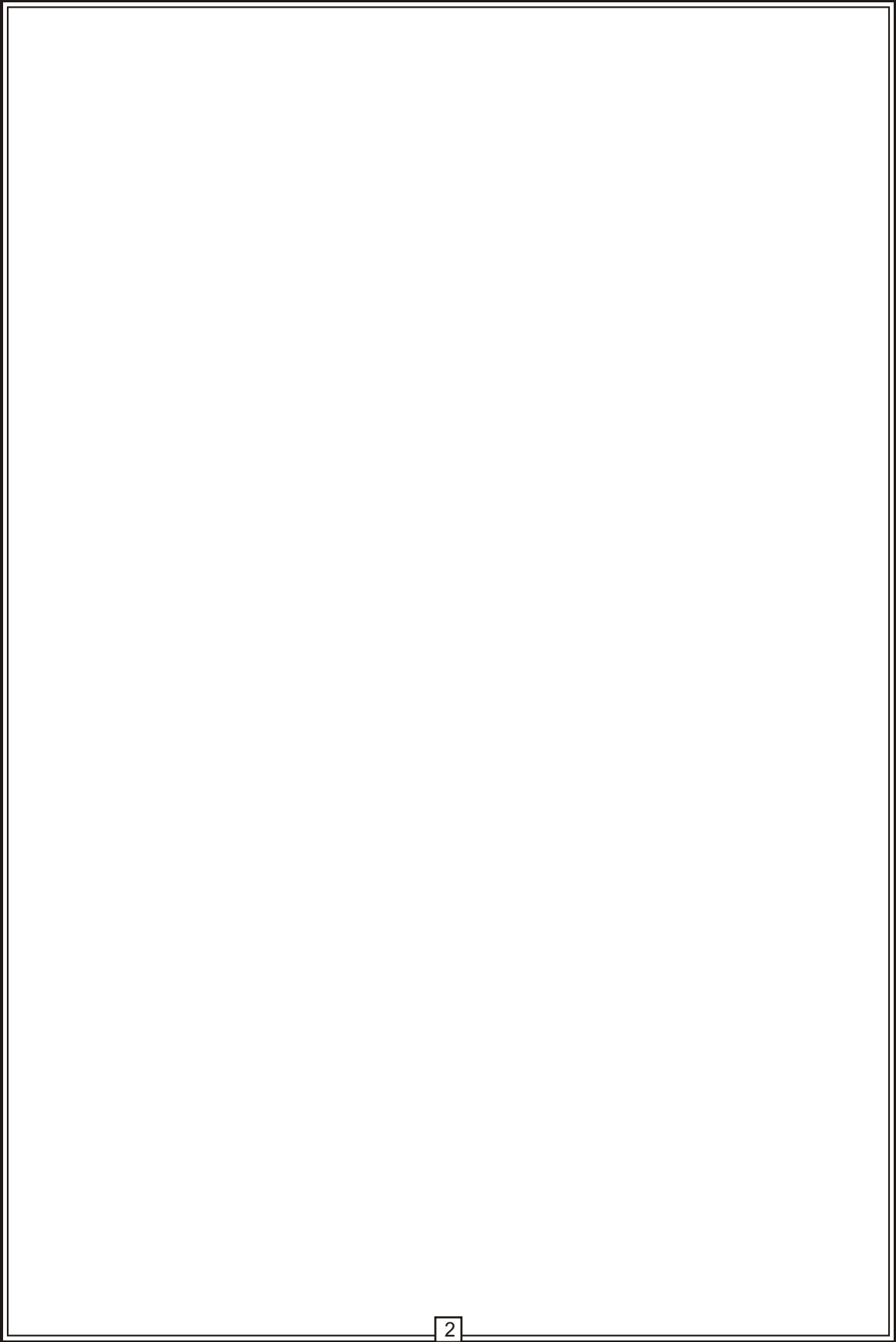

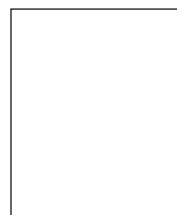

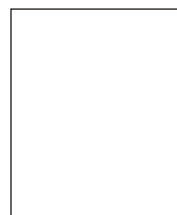

**SPECIAL FEATURES**

The medium of instruction is English

The School follows the three language formula. English, taught as the first language, is compulsory for all classes. Hindi and Tamil are offered as second language from class Grade 1 to Grade 10 (However, Hindi can be taken either as second language or third language).

The School is set amidst natural surroundings.

The School believes in the all round development of the child.

Independence Day, Teacher's Day, Gandhi Jayanthi, Children's Day, Republic Day and Festivals likem Dussehra, Diwali, Pongal, Eid, Christmas and Holi are celebrated to make the children aware of their importance.

The School has planned field trips and excursions are arranged as extensions of the teaching - learning process in the class room activities.

The School believes in instilling Sound Moral Values in the young minds to build up a good Society.

Regular open house sessions are held wherein the parents meet the teachers to discuss the progress of their wards.

### **ADMISSIONS**

Application for admission must be made on the prescribed form available at the School Office.

Admission is granted on the basis of age criterion only.

For admission the student must have attained the age mentioned below by the month of August.

### **FEE REGULATIONS**

The School fee is charged for 12 months to be paid in two installments.

A late fee of Rs. 150/- will be charged for a delay upto 15 days after which Rs. 15 per day will be charged over and above the late fee as late charges. No parent should approach the school authorities for waiver of late fees.

No reduction of fees is made for holidays or broken periods of attendance or which drawal of a child before vacation.

## **ATTENDANCE**

Children must attend the school regularly and must reach school punctually five minutes before the bell.

Once the child is in school, he / she will be permitted to leave only after the last bell, except in an emergency with the permission of the principal.

In case of illness, it is best advised that the student can take rest and stay at home.

A student returning to school after suffering from an infectious or contagious disease, must produce a doctor's certificate of good health permitting him/her to attend the school.

## **WITHDRAWAL**

If a parent wished to withdraw their ward at the end of the year, application for Transfer certificate should be given in writing to the Principal by the parent by the month of February.

Transfer Certificate is issued only when all the dues of the school are settled.

Transfer Certificate will be issued after all the dues are cleared and clearance form is completed. T.C. Should be collected only by the parents from the school office.

## **TRANSPORT**

It is advised for all students upto Grade 5 to either use school van / bus or be dropped personally by their parents.

The routes of the school vans are drawn - up and parents should consult the school transport incharge and not the drivers directly.

Van / Bus fees will have to be remitted along with the tuition fees.

The school does not entertain any change in the van route to suit the individual's convenience.

Students are expected to be on the right side of their bus stops along with escorting person at least five minutes before the arrival of the Van / Bus, Vans will not wait for the late comers.

Commuters are not allowed to change school vans or go by other means of transport without written permission from the principal.

When the van is in motion students must not move in the bus and no part of their body should be outside the van, students are not allowed to play games in the vans and objects of any kind must not be discarded inside or thrown outside the van.

Discipline has to be maintained at all costs as it is important for their safe journey. The drivers attention must not be diverted for any reason if any such case comes to notice bus / van facility may be cancelled.

### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

Every student is expected to be courteous in talk and behaviour at all times. They must use polite expressions like " Thank You, Excuse me, Sorry, Please " etc.

All are expected to speak English at all times in the school premises except during other language classes.

The classroom and school premises should be kept neat and tidy.

Parents are requested to check the school Hand book Daily and Sign all the communications. Any message to the teachers shall be communicated in writing preferably through the Hand book. The parents should ask their ward to show such communications to the class teacher and obtain initials as soon as the ward reaches the school.

Visitors including parents will not be allowed to meet the teachers or the students during the class hours without prior permission from the principal. Permission and appointment must be sought before two days
